Spacey door prizes will be offered for children, along with outside viewing for all, weather permitting.

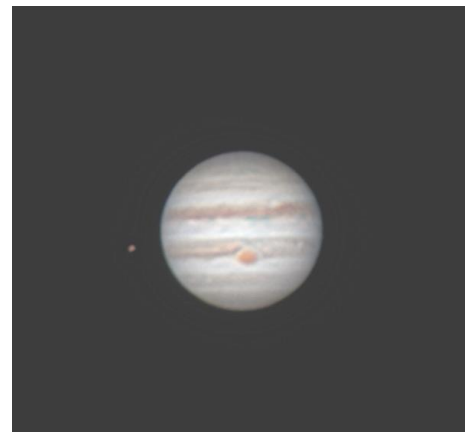


Figure 2: Jupiter & Io captured by Aldrich astrophotographer Charlie Stevenson on March 30 2016!
