Elmwood students who live beyond a two mile radius of the school will be bused home or to a daycare within Hopkinton without charge. Students living within a two mile radius of Elmwood must purchase a bus pass to ride the bus. Streets not eligible for town paid (free) transportation are posted on the District's webpage under Departments and then Transportation. If those students do not purchase a bus pass, they may walk or be transported by parent/guardian to and from school.
