Entrance Requirements: Massachusetts state law requires that all students entering kindergarten must have a current physical exam, all required immunizations, and a preschool vision screening prior to the start of the school year. A Massachusetts School Health Record form is attached but we also accept your health care provider's standard form. HOPKINTON SCHOOL COMMITTEE POLICY REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ENTRANCE

Effective September, 1999, children living in the Town of Hopkinton who have attained the age of five (5) years as of August 31, are eligible for enrollment in Kindergarten in September of the calendar year in which they attain the age of five (5) years.

Children who have not attended public Kindergarten will be enrolled in first grade in September, provided they attain their sixth birthday by August 31 of the calendar year in which they attain the age of six (6) years.

Children living outside of Hopkinton, enrolled in public pre-school programs leading to promotion to first grade in their sending community, will be permitted to advance to first grade upon completion of their pre-school program and moving to Hopkinton.

Children living in the Town of Hopkinton, who have reached the age of three (3) years and have been found through the TEAM evaluation process under Chapter 766 of the Acts of 1972 to have special needs, will be provided by the Hopkinton Public Schools with an appropriate educational program consistent with the child's educational plan.
